This Hispanic mission church has outgrown their present rented facility and the contract ends June 30, 2008. The average Sunday AM attendance is 35 to 40. The Associational Missionary, Dennis Pulley, and his Associate, Wally Vinson, commend Freddy to FBC. He was ordained to the gospel ministry in 2006 by Trinity Baptist Church. He affirms the Baptist Faith and Message, and he believes the Bible to be infallible and inerrant. Pastor Freddy Valcarcel and his wife have five children. This proposal has worked its way through the Senior Pastor, the Executive Staff and Deacon Officers. It has been approved by the Missions Committee. The Deacons approved this proposal Sunday, May 18. It was presented to FBC in business session Wednesday, May 28 and passed. Associate Pastor Bill Graham will be the supervisor of the Hispanic Mission Pastor. The Sunday School space will be in the lower level of FAITH. The worship service will be in the lower level of HOPE across from the gym.

Week of June 22, 2008: **A divorced mother** also a teacher with three children diagnosed with ovarian cancer; **A wife** whose husband was killed in action June 28, 2005 four days after his birthday...they have two daughters...praise God for her faith in the Lord and work with grieving families at Ft. Campbell; **A man** needing help with medicine and health needs to heal his arm so he can use them again...requested with thanksgiving to Jesus; **A soldier** due to deploy soon to join his unit until January needs prayer for safety, leadership and opportunities to share Christ with his unit; **A daughter and son-in-law** on a mission trip to Moldova...he preaches June 22 in local church...their three children under five will stay with two families...asking for safety and God's plan to be carried out and that the kids stay healthy and content; **A woman** with cancer...also, pray for a person needing surgery; **A two year old foster girl** who was given back to her biological mother this week after being with a family for almost two years...her biological mother is Italian and speaks little English...pray for the child's safety and provision and that she will not detach but thrive in her new home in FL and that the FL DHS will keep track of her and her care...pray for the foster family to be comforted in this loss; **A person** suggesting a wheelchair ministry for many struggling and may have frail spouses; **A 93 year old grandmother** who is healing from a fall...she broke three ribs and her arm...pray for complete healing and the Lord's will be done when it's her time to go home and be with Him; **A young man** soon to be attending Airborne School in Ft. Benning, GA; **A daughter's** visitation hearing in court June 30 needing much prayer; **A woman** admitted to Gateway and a man having surgery June 23; **A woman** needing prayer for her back...she's in much pain and having trouble sleeping; **A father** recovering from cancer surgery; **A divorced woman** asking prayer for her family and the ability to provide for her children without having to depend on child support...she desires peace in her life and to be able to be a good provider for her children; **A brother** lost sight in his left eye...doctors relieved pressure but he's having much pain...a possible carotid blockage...he's diabetic and has heart disease...he needs to be drawn to Jesus; **A sister-in-law** in the hospital with colon blockage...also, one of her kidneys has a tumor and the kidney is four times normal size...she has gall stones and her gall bladder needs to be removed...possible cancerous kidney...pray for doctors to have wisdom in decisions and for the husband and family.

Week of June 15, 2008: **All deployed soldiers**...also, her father with cancer not doing well with treatments...also, asking for patience with family and kids and her grandmother with Parkinson's has been in hospital and now needs full time care; **A sister** feeling poorly, has a college exam soon and has a mole suspected to be cancerous due to be removed on June 26; **A deployed Major** as well as all deployed military and their families; **A woman** who was recently baptized and a man encouraging prayer of protection from our enemies as a nation; **A woman** due to have back surgery June 23; **A soldier** in Iraq due home in three and a half months...also, pray for his wife and son; **A family** with travel, health and guidance needs...also, pray for an injured woman and a man with health problems and his wife caring for him; **A family** asks for continued prayer for their home to sell; **A sister** with kidney failure in a distant location; **A woman** divorcing her homosexual spouse needs prayer for emotional and spiritual warfare...also, financial situation is difficult; **A sister** who has been sick for three days; **A family** struggling with a defiant child; **A 16 year old young man** who jumped from a moving vehicle suffering broken bones and a head injury...also, pray for his family; **A seven week old baby** recently tested for a heart murmur and taking medicine for acid reflux...the hope is that his heart will heal itself and he will be retested in six months.

Week of June 8, 2008: **A missionary couple** leaving their assignment in Malaysia in a few months asking prayer for all of their work to continue and that the Lord send local pastors and pray for their health; **A brother** with cancer began chemotherapy 6/6 needing 12-18 weeks, 4-5 rounds; **A mother** in a nursing home after hospitalization...family asking that she feels the love of God, grows in patience and strength through Christ's love; **A family** adjusting to the loss of a loved one and other turmoil in their lives; **A grandfather** with cancer in his brain, lungs and liver beginning radiation; **A woman** in her second round of chemotherapy with four weeks to go; **The family** of a woman found by her teenage grandson after she collapsed and passed away...she had a very close bond with the one who found her; **A woman** praising God for a teaching position with middle school students also asking that she and her Christian principle and others will be spreading the love of Christ.
