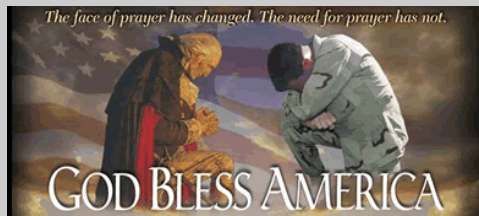
The 40/40 Prayer Vigil for Spiritual Revival and National Renewal:

Week of August 24, 2008: **A man** with a broken back is home from the hospital and will be off work for six weeks; **Barksdale** faculty, staff, students and parents; **A woman** in ICU at Gateway and a doctor in St. Thomas; **A daughter and son in law** as he seeks a job...ask God to lead and guide him; **A woman** needing healing from cancer, paralysis of legs and recent surgery as well as her husband, daughter and two sons-this is an urgent situation...also pray for peace and the drought; **A brother** as he deploys to the Middle East next week; **A father** to be safe, a friend's family, for students to have a good school year, for teachers, for her school-Clarksville Academy, for her friends, for her father to come home soon, for her house, for her dad to have wisdom, and for everybody who is saved to tell people about Jesus; **Coaches** and football team at CHS, for the student and the student's family and friends, asking to “watch over me while I try to get back right with God and become a better Christian” and “that I better myself with God as well as grow in mind, spirit and body”; **A son** needing God to encourage and draw him to Himself and Christian fellowship and that God would lead and provide him a better job that is right and good for him at the right time; **A son** to be able to find a job within the medical field as he moved to a new city over a month ago to fulfill residency requirements for medical school next fall...he needs experience in the medical field to make him competitive in consideration for the available medical school positions; **An aunt** to know Jesus and a sibling needs help not to be bossy to a brother; **A daughter and son in law** needing to again find the will of God in their lives...the daughter is living with a grandmother for a few months-pray she will get into God's word and hear His voice and return to serve her Savior...they both need to be reminded that Jesus is the only way to God; **A second cousin** in an auto accident with a broken neck and is paralyzed but does have some movement in his hand and fingers..pray for God's healing; **A brother** at Buffalo valley and person requesting also needs prayer; **(Update) A soldier** still recovering from a helicopter crash...he is still paralyzed and is having difficulty getting help through the VA in having the necessary ramps and an elevator installed in his Clarksville home...family needs much prayer.

Week of August 17, 2008: **Austin Peay State University** staff and students...the APSU Dorm Move In outreach the next few days will encourage those who may have fears...God's will be accomplished; **A man** who left rehab where he accepted Christ and is still struggling with his habits and some depression; **A husband** having hip replacement August 20 at Gateway...he has not been hospitalized in 67 years; Barksdale School; A man with pancreas cancer; **A person** with terminal cancer needing stamina and enjoyment for the rest of life; **A woman** with deep depression; **A woman** with an unspoken; **A mother** of three recuperating from cancer and paralysis of her legs; **A man** deploying to the Middle East the first week of September; **A man** not acting like himself and needs God; **First Baptist Church**; **Those people** suffering with depression.

Week of August 10, 2008: **An aunt** with breast cancer due to have a complicated surgery since she has a pace-maker...pray for the doctors to be guided by God to make the best decisions toward a successful surgery; **A man** having surgery at Vanderbilt August 26; **College students** leaving home to go to school . . .pray also for crime victims and families and safety in Clarksville; **A family** with a husband with addictions that have almost destroyed the marriage and family...the children and wife are dealing with emotions. . .also pray for a home to sell; **A mother** placing her home on the market this week due to her being placed in a nursing home; **Deployed soldiers** and their families; **School children** and their teachers; **Police, firefighters and paramedics** need prayer for safety; **US Election** this year; **A man** in the hospital.
