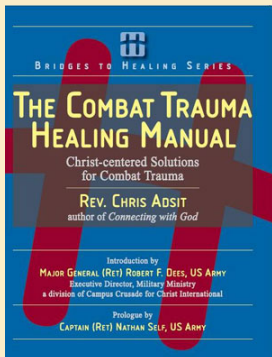

Report from Sept. Trip:

Below is the professional observations of Dr. Prine as he worked in the Baptist Medical Center in Nalerigu, W. Africa.

“I have not been stressed as professionally since 3rd year medical through 1st year residency as I was at Baptist Medical Center in Nalerigu. I have not been as stressed Spiritually as I was during that week. I am overwhelmed by what needs to be done there medically and Spiritually.

There is no question with me that we need to be there. There is so much to be done spiritually, educationally, and medically that I see us there until the rapture. If we are to be successful long term we must start churches in the villages. However, to do this we must build relationships and partnerships in areas where the villages interact.

This would include the BMC, the schools, the public health sector and the nutritional clinic which is a part of the BMC. To this purpose we need teachers of an academic nature including ESL teachers as well as those who can do nutritional and health education. We really need surgeon types in the hospital. Docs like myself can make the docs there have easier days, but really do not increase the level of care very much. I think we also need people who do evangelistic work. I would try to get Jay to advocate for an evangelism team on the grounds of BMC. BUT, it may be better to ask the docs and Jane to help facilitate this. They could help us with the constraints to make it work. I think assigning a chaplain each day to be the interpreter would be beneficial. I suspect our evangelists would be educational for them. We have enough contacts now in all these areas that we can do some semblance of planning once we have put a team together. With this we must always keep in mind the African way of change at the last minute and no sense of time constraints.
