Week of July 20, 2008: **A man** having back surgery at Baptist Hospital July 21st...vertebra in the lower back will be fused; **A family** moving to Ramstein Germany asking for transition to be as easy as possible; **A man** requesting a closer walk with Christ; **A woman** needing comfort in a time of loss; **A woman** needing spiritual guidance and asking for FBC to continue their path of spreading the Word without conflict and internal turmoil; **A mother** requesting prayer for her daughter and son-in-law moving to NYC...that God will protect them and surround them with Christian friends that will help and love them...that she, the mother, will have a peace about this more as she has worries and concerns that any mother would have; **A wife** asking prayer for her husband as he interviews for job positions...that God will lead him to the job he wants and God's positioning; **A person** praying for a Sunday school for adults with teenage children; **A woman** with several job interviews this week is a little nervous...asking that God would lead her to encouraging scriptures, would give her wisdom and foresight to answer questions and give her an attitude of faith about the plans for her and would help her in her future profession; **A man** needing peace within his heart regarding his current job and his future in that position; **A sister** asking prayer for her Buddhist sister with ovarian cancer needing salvation, God's healing if He wills and for their parents and herself to be a witness to her; **A woman** accepting Christ today asking prayer for herself; **A daughter** requesting prayer for her mother, age 75, in a health care center has not made progress in her rehab and seems discouraged...asking for strength and that friends would visit and remember her; **A military couple** asking prayer for the husband at Ft. Lewis, WA for training-asking wisdom for all cadets and leaders, for safety for all in rigorous training...the wife has seven work days before leaving for annual Reserve training in San Antonio, TX-asking for excellent use of time to leave things in good shape at work and to prepare well for instructors duty...praise the Lord for protecting each of them while apart and for keeping them connected over the miles; **A friend** with breast cancer meeting with doctors July 24 to determine the treatment and other; **A man** needing to turn back to God; **A man** very sick not off of antibiotics and four others needing prayer; **A woman** praising God for signed divorce papers and asking prayer for ex-husband to come to faith and reject homosexuality; **A grandfather** and his family as he fears death from cancer and strength for the family and less pain for the grandfather; **A praise** for answered prayers; **A mother** praising God for answered prayer of her son's health issues-he's doing well; **Two praising** God for answered prayer of guidance and security as well as a better job and family life; **“God is good all the time! God Bless First Baptist”**; **A father** had to go to the hospital for his arm-his daughter asking for prayer; **A praise** from a woman about her new job as 6th grade math teacher; **A Chaplain** expecting to be a witness in a trial this week asking prayer for himself through this heavy burden.

Week of July 13, 2008: **A woman** having heart tests July 13; **A woman** recovering at home and her husband caring for her; **A man** had an EMG test indicating a problem and need for more testing- a brain MRI...he is feeling fine but his mother died of brain cancer; **The family** of a woman killed by her husband a year ago July-four children, parents and her ex-husband; **The family** of a woman who went to be with Jesus July 7; **A daughter** who is four months pregnant with pain from a previous c-section and testing found a hernia in her abdomen...she is a high risk pregnancy and has a two year old; **A man** recovering after double by-pass surgery and his wife caring for him...he recently recovered from Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever; **A sister** having surgery July 15 and her husband is deployed; **11 FBC members** in Ghana, West Africa needing safety and God's will be done; **A man** praising God he is returning to work but needs strength as he's in much pain and needs more prayer; **A military wife** whose husband has been deployed 10 months (a praise that he is due home in November rather than after Christmas) is exhausted and asking God to give her strength to be everything for her four children ages 10, 8, 6 and 2...he has been deployed five times previously...she also needs travel mercies as visiting grandparents; **A family** in tremendous turmoil needing healing and reconciliation for five of them during this critical time for teenagers; **A helicopter pilot** recovering after a crash is beginning to get some feeling back in his legs after breaking his back; **A family** buying a house and closing soon asking for prayer over the situation; **A man** needing a closer walk, a woman needing healing, a woman needing comfort in loss and a man needing healing as he came home from the hospital July 10.
