Pray Across North America

Join Southern Baptists in praying for every heart and every mile of North America, focusing on those who need a relationship with Jesus Christ. Here are some things to keep in mind as you prepare to pray:

1. **Pray with insight.** Be aware of where you are praying. What do you see along your prayer journey. Does a loved, a neighbor, a co-worker come to mind? Then pray for that person or family at that moment. Pray that people will discover the light of Christ and that believers will be a light to the world.
2. **Pray with intentionality.** Always be sensitive to how the Holy Spirit leads you to pray. Pray specifically for those in your community who need to hear the Gospel.
3. **Pray with the heart of an intercessor.** Look for opportunities to pray specifically with people and for people's needs.
4. **Pray with information.** Do you know who lives in your community? How many single parents are there? What unreached people groups are living in your town? Learn about the needs in your community.
5. **Pray with inspiration.** Prayerwalk with Scripture verses. Pray God's promises.
6. **Pray for the impossible and expect God to answer!** Are you limiting God and His ability to answer prayer? Pray with confidence that God can redeem anyone.

Friday-Pray for our Deaf Ministry workers as they prepare for ministry every week to our deaf and hard of hearing members and guests.

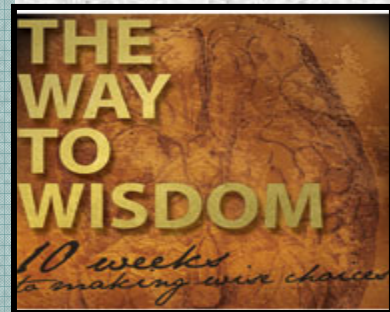
Saturday-Pray for your family to prepare for Worship s as God speaks, you will respond in accordance with His Will.

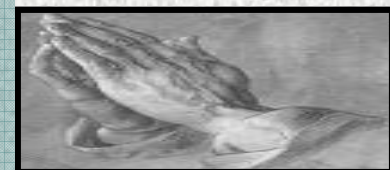

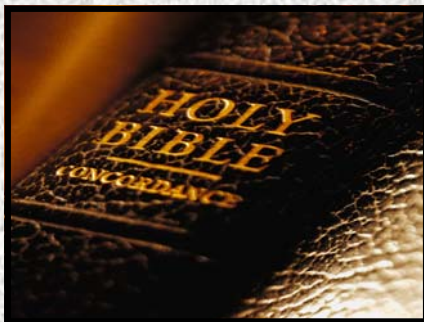
